

REGULATIONS

on holding the International competition in fire and rescue sport for the Cup «Friendship» and prize «Golden assault ladder» in the frameworks of the 13th Integrated Safety and Security Exhibition 2021

1. Goals and objectives

The International competition in fire and rescue sport for the Cup «Friendship» and the prize «Golden assault ladder» in the frameworks of the 13th Integrated Safety and Security Exhibition 2021 (further - Competitions) is aimed at:

- international sports cooperation and strengthening friendly relations between fire and rescue services in different countries;
- promotion of professionalism and high sports achievements of the firefighters and rescuers during the events of the Exhibition;
- development and popularization of the profession of firefighters and rescuers;
- improvement of professional and sportsmanship of workers in fire and rescue services;
- popularization and development of fire and rescue sport among the population of different countries.

2. Organization of competitions

Competitions are held under the auspices of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers.

The general management and organization of competitions is carried out by the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers in cooperation with the Ministry of the Russian Federation for Civil Defense, Emergency Situations and Elimination of Consequences of Natural Disasters and the All-Russian public organization "Federation of Fire and Rescue Sport of Russia".

The direct organization and conduct of competitions (preparation of competition venues, meeting and sending participants, medical care, provision of sports and technical equipment, catering and accommodation, cultural and leisure program, VIP-zone, media coverage, etc.) is carried out by the Federal State Institution "Center for Physical Training and Sports of the Ministry of Emergency Situations of Russia" together with the All-Russian public organization "Federation of Fire and Rescue Sport of Russia".

Competitions are held in accordance with the Rules of competitions in fire and rescue (fire-applied) sport, approved by the International Conference of the Non-profit partnership "International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers" in 2019.

3. Dates and venue of the competition

Competitions are held: from 11 to 14 May 2021.

Venue: Patriot Park, Moscow Region.

4. Participants and conditions of admission

The men's and women's national teams of the member countries of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers take part in the competition by invitation.

The composition of the sports delegation – 33 people, including: head of the delegation-1, team representative-2, coach-2, doctor-2, judge-2, press-2, translator-2, athletes: men-10, women-10.

Changes in the quantitative composition of the delegation are allowed, taking into account the declared athletes and sports personnel.

The women's national team may include athletes at least 14 years of age. Age is determined by the year of birth.

Representatives of the teams submit to the mandate commission a personal application and a passport (or identification card) of the athlete. Athletes are not allowed to compete without these documents. Applications are submitted separately for the men's team and the women's team.

5. Program of the competition

- 11 May**
- Arrival of teams, accreditation of sports delegations
 - Commission for the admission of athletes
 - Testing the training tower
 - Meeting of representatives of teams and the Main Panel of Referees
 - Drawing of lots
- 12 May**
- Climbing the assault ladder to the 4th and 2nd floors of the training tower (preliminary races)
 - Grand opening of the competitions
 - The final runs in the climbing of the assault ladder to the 4th and 2nd floor of the training tower
 - Awarding of winners and prize-winners
- 13 May**
- Visiting of the 13th Integrated Safety and Security Exhibition 2021
- 14 May**
- Teams departure

6. The system of scoring and evaluation in a sports discipline

Men, women

Sports discipline	Amount	Required
Climbing the assault ladder to the 4th floor of the training tower (men)	8 participants	6 results
Climbing the assault ladder to the 2nd floor of the training tower (women)	8 participants	6 results

7. Conditions for identify the team championship and the individual championship

The team championship among men's and women's national sports teams is held separately. The team championship is determined by the lowest amount of time scored by the valid participants. If the amount of time is equal, the team that has the best result of the individual championship of athletes has the advantage. The team that does not get the full number of minimum required results is nominated after teams that have the full minimum required result. In case of equality of incomplete tests – by the smallest amount of time of the test participants.

The individual championship is identified among all the declared participants of the national sports teams separately for men and women according to the best result of one of the two attempts. If the results are equal – by the best sum of the time of two attempts, if the sum of the time of two attempts is equal – by the best result of the first attempt, then – who started earlier.

Semi-final races are formed according to the results of preliminary races according to the scheme: 1 semi-final race - 5,1,4,8 result, 2 semi-final race - 6,2,3,7

result. The final race is formed according to the results of the semifinal races according to the scheme: 4,2,1,3 result.

8. Award ceremony

The teams that take the 1,2,3 place among the men's and women's national sports teams of the participating countries are awarded with cups and diplomas.

Participants who take the 1,2,3 place in the individual championship are awarded with medals, diplomas and gifts.

The coaches of the men's and women's national sports teams that took the 1,2,3 place in the competition are awarded with medals, diplomas and gifts.

9. Conditions for the arrival of sports delegations and participants of competitions

Expenses associated with sending sports delegations (travel, accommodation, meals, daily allowances on the way, maintaining wages, etc.) are the responsibility of the countries, sending the delegation to the competitions.

Expenses of the competition are the responsibility of the organizers of the competition at the expense of their own and borrowed funds in the manner prescribed by law.

10. Procedure and terms of providing the applications

The preliminary application (official letter) for participation and the number of members of the sports delegation is sent by April 15, 2021.

Teams application for participation in competitions in sports disciplines is provided to the mandate commission on the day when holding the drawing of lots on May 11, 2021.

The registration form of the established sample is sent until April 15, 2021 by e-mail: isffr.2001@gmail.com.

This information will be used by the organizers of the competition for arrival/departure, booking rooms and accommodation at the hotel, preparing accreditation badges and solving other organizational issues.
