RESOLUTION

On Approval of the Sport and Disciplinary Commission

In pursuance of the Plan of the main sporting events of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers for 2021 and the Resolution of the XXI International Conference of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers dated December 08, 2020 No. 4 «On approval of the regulations of the 2021 World Championships», were organized and held 4 world championships among men, women, boys and girls.

In order to carry out control and disciplinary functions for the observance of sports discipline and sports ethics, the execution of regulatory documents and regulations on competitions by participants at the 2021 World Championships, a Sport Disciplinary Commission worked.

At the X World Championship among boys and juniors and the VI World Championship among girls and juniors in fire and rescue (fire-applied) sport, a commission consisting of:

- N. Rebrova (Russian Federation);
- M. Andrienko (Republic of Belarus);
- R. Zadravec (Republic of Croatia).
- At the XVI World Championship among men and the VII World Championship among women in fire and rescue (fire-applied) sport, a commission consisting of:
 - N. Rebrova (Russian Federation);
 - S. Donskih (Czech Republic);
 - S. Zhakypbekov (Republic of Kazakhstan).

After hearing and discussing the report of the Chairman of the Sport Disciplinary Commission, the XXII International Conference of International Association «International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers» has decided:

- 1. The moral and ethical situation in the competitive and out-of-competition periods of the 2021 World Championships is generally considered satisfactory, and the quality of execution of regulatory documents is appropriate, taking into account the following points:
- absence of written (oral) appeals, complaints and other statements about disciplinary violations committed by competitors during the World Championships;
- timely fulfillment of the requirements and instructions emanating from the Main Judging Panel, members of committees, commissions and heads of sports delegations in compliance with the principles of subordination and mutual relations in the field of sports activities;
- making constructive decisions within the framework of professional competence and a qualifying sports position in the event of difficult sports situations and disagreements.
- 2. The work of the management and coaching staff of sports delegations on the formation of sports-ethical and moral principles of the competitors, based on mutual respect, loyalty, tolerance and moral and volitional qualities of each athlete, is generally satisfactory to evaluate.
- 3. Based on the results of the work in 2021, taking into account the existing disciplinary violations, the Sport Disciplinary Commission recommends:
- representatives of the Republic of Belarus to make a remark for inappropriate behavior during international competitions (Ilya Bondarenko);
- representatives of the Russian Federation to make a remark for inappropriate behavior during international competitions (Maltseva Alyona);
- representatives of the Czech Republic to make a remark for inappropriate behavior during international competitions (Krpec Pavel);

- coaches of the Republic of Belarus, the Russian Federation, the Czech Republic, following the results of the World Championships, conduct educational work with members of national teams on compliance with the Rules of international competitions in fire and rescue sport.
