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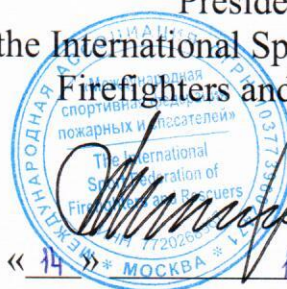

RESOLUTION

October 27, 2023

**On amendments and additions
to the International rules of the competitions
in fire and rescue sport**

Having considered and discussed proposals for amendments and additions to the International rules of the competitions in fire and rescue sport, the XXIV International Conference of the International Association "International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers" **decided:**

1. Make the following changes and additions to the International rules in fire and rescue sport:

Paragraph 1.1. – to state in the following wording: "The international rules of the competitions in fire and rescue sport are mandatory for states that have joined the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers during international competitions."

Paragraph 2.5.5. – to exclude.

Paragraph 3.1.4. – should be worded as follows: "If the referee made a mistake in refereeing during the competition (race) (violated the requirements of the Rules, the order and sequence of the competition, etc.), he must be removed from subsequent refereeing (replaced by another referee) with an appropriate entry in the referee's card."

Paragraph 3.3.2 c) – to exclude.

Paragraph 3.7.2. – should be worded as follows: "The Chief secretary is responsible for the correctness of the processing of protocols, general results and the determination of occupied places by athletes and teams."

Paragraph 3.9.6. b) – to state in the following wording: "Check the turnout of athletes of the next race, make a note of the turnout in the start protocol, inform the finish line about the non-appearance of athletes before the start. After fixing the results of the previous race, give the athletes a command to prepare for the next race and fix the set time of 2 minutes in the disciplines of climbing the assault ladder to the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors of the training tower and overcoming a 100-meter obstacle course and the set time of 5 minutes in the combat deployment."

Paragraph 3.14.1. – to add to the text of the rules: "The referee at the wind speed measurement in the discipline 100-meter obstacle course ensures control of the device (anemometer) and records the value of the speed and direction of the tailwind to the movement of the athlete in the starting protocol."

Paragraph 3.15.2. – to add paragraph e) to the text of the rules: "Exclude the maintenance of information at the start of the next race of athletes (teams)."

Paragraph 4.1.5. – should be worded as follows: "In competitions in climbing the assault ladder and overcoming the 100-meter obstacle course, the formation of semifinal races is carried out according to the best results of the preliminary races shown by athletes in one of two attempts according to the scheme, 1-semifinal race - 5,1,4,8 result. 2-semifinal race - 6,2,3,7 result. In the case of athletes showing the same results in the preliminary races, the athlete who started earlier has the advantage. If these results were shown in one race, the athlete who had the best time sum of the two attempts in the preliminaries.

The final race is formed according to the 4 best results shown in the semifinal races according to the scheme 3,1,2,4. If these results are the same, the athlete who started earlier. If these results were shown in one race, the athlete who had the best result in the preliminaries."

Paragraph 4.2.4. a) – to state in the following wording: "Before the start, the starter's assistants place the athletes approximately 3 m from the starting line, check the numbers of the occupied track recorded in the protocol; explain to the athletes how the signal will be given to start the race and return in case of an unsuccessful start (with a shot, voice, whistle); explain rules for the use of starting pads."

Paragraph 4.2.4. i) – should be worded as follows: "After making sure that all athletes have correctly occupied a fixed starting position, the starter fires a shot from the starting pistol."

Paragraph 4.3.2. a) should be worded as follows: "The judging panel has the right to withdraw an athlete (team) from competitions in this sports discipline:
– for passing any segment of the distance along the adjacent track, leading to a shortening of the distance.

The exception is cases of switching to an adjacent track as a result of an obvious loss of balance, falling when provided that this did not interfere with another athlete, including after a premature descent from the house and boom, after which the athlete must repeat overcoming the projectile.

Also, the exception is the zone (5 meters) after extinguishing the flammable liquid in the relay of the participants of the 4th stage from the edge of the container for extinguishing the burning liquid."

Paragraph 4.7.6 h) – should be worded as follows: "During competitions in the fire relay, a combustible mixture is poured into a container for extinguishing burning liquid in the volume: water – 30 liters, diesel fuel – 2 liters, gasoline (Ai 95) – 0.25 liters. Testing of fire extinguishers is carried out on the day of testing shells according to the schedule."


Paragraph 5. COMPETITION VENUES, EQUIPMENT AND APPLIANCES
To add paragraph g) into the text of the Rules: "During competitions in all types of programs, a countdown scoreboard (2 minutes, 5 minutes) must be used to control the preparation of athletes for the start."

Paragraph 5.1.2. h) should be worded as follows: "On each floor of the tower there should be platforms with a depth (from the working side) of at least 2.5 m, and each platform should have access to a stationary staircase. A stationary staircase with a guardrail is installed inside the tower on one of its non-working sides."

Paragraph 5.2.5. a) – to state in the following wording: "Fence – 23 m from the start line; fence height – 2 m (+ 1 cm) (for boys of younger and middle age groups – 1.7 m (+ 1 cm), for girls, juniors and women – 0.7 m (+ 1 cm); with a folding, fixed upper bar - (0.1 m); width – 2 m; fence wall 40-50 mm thick;

material is stuffed (glued) onto the fence from both sides to improve adhesion (rubber or its equivalent) (**appendix No. 9**)."
