REGULATION

on holding the International Competitions in fire and rescue sport for the Cup "Friendship" and the prize "Golden assault ladder"

1. Goals and objectives of the competitions

The International Competitions in fire and rescue sport for the Cup "Friendship" and the prize "Golden assault ladder" (hereinafter referred to as competitions) are held in order to:

- implement international sports cooperation and strengthen friendly ties with fire and rescue services around the world;
- promote and demonstrate the level of professionalism of firefighters and rescuers;
 - further develop and popularize the profession of firefighter and rescuer;
- improve the professional and athletic skills of employees and employees of fire and rescue services;
- prepare for the XIX World Championship among men and women X World Championship among women in fire and rescue sport.

2. Organization of competitions

Competitions are held under the auspices of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers.

The general management and organization of the competition is carried out by the Ministry of the Russian Federation for Civil Defense, Emergencies and Elimination of Consequences of Natural Disasters in cooperation with All-Russian public organization "Federation of Fire and Rescue Sports of Russia" and Administration of the Volgograd region.

The direct organization and conduct of competitions (preparation of competition venues, transfer of the participants, medical care, provision of sports and technical equipment, catering and accommodation, cultural and leisure program, media coverage, etc.) is carried out by the Main Office of the Russian Emergency Situations Ministry in Volgograd Region together with federal state institution "Center of Physical Training and Sports of the EMERCOM of Russia", the Committee for Ensuring the Safety of the Population of the Volgograd region, the Committee for Physical Culture and Sports of the Volgograd Region, the All-Russian Public Organization "Federation of Fire and Rescue Sports of Russia" and the Regional Public Organization "Federation of Fire and Rescue Sports of the Volgograd Region".

The competitions are held in accordance with the Rules of competition in firerescue sport, approved by the International Conference of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers in 2023.

3. Dates and venue of the competitions

Competitions are held: from 15 to 21 of May 2024. Venue: the Russian Federation (Volgograd city).

4. Competitors and admission conditions

The competitions are attended by the national teams of men and women of the member countries of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers, as well as teams of other countries upon invitation.

The sports delegation consists of 33 people, including: the head of the delegation -1, the team representative -2, coach -4, doctor -1, judge -2, press -2, translator -1, athletes: men -10, women -10.

It is allowed to change the quantitative structure of delegation taking into account the declared athletes and the sports personnel.

The President of the national federation of the country participating in the competition has the right to change the composition of the delegation at his discretion, except the athletes participating in the competition.

The representatives of teams need to submit the signed application and passport (or identity card) to credentials committee. Athletes are not allowed to compete without

these documents. Applications are submitted separately for the men's team and the women's team.

6. The system of scoring and evaluation in sports disciplines

Men, women

Sports discipline	Composition	Results
Climbing the assault ladder to the 4 th and 2 nd floors of the training tower	8 people	6 results
Overcoming the 100-meter obstacle course	8 people	6 results
Fire relay 4x100 meters	2 teams	1 result
Combat deployment	1 team	1 result

Competitions in climbing the assault ladder to the 4^{th} and 2^{nd} floors of the training tower, overcoming the 100-meter obstacle course, combat deployment are held in two attempts.

7. Conditions for defining the team and individual championship

The all-team championship among men and women is determined by the smallest number of places occupied by teams in all sports disciplines. If the sum of the places is equal, the highest place is awarded to the team with the best result in combat deployment.

The team championship in sports disciplines is determined by the smallest amount of time scored by the test participants. If the sum of the amounts of time is equal, teams are awarded the same place (subsequent place is not awarded). The team that has not scored the full number of scoring results is assigned a place after the teams that have a full score. In case of equality of incomplete scores – one should be guided by the smallest amount of time of the scoring participants.

Individual championship in the disciplines is determined by the best result of scoring attempts. In case of equality of results of two or more athletes, the advantage is given to the athlete who started earlier. If these results were shown in one race, the best place is awarded to the athlete who had the best sum of the time of two attempts in the preliminary races.

In case of equality of results in the fire relay, the highest place is awarded to the team that started earlier.

To determine the winners and prize-winners, semifinal and final races are held in overcoming the 100-meter obstacle course and climbing the assault ladder to the 4th and 2nd floors of the training tower. The number of athletes in the semifinal and final races is determined by the number of racetracks. The results of the semifinal and final races are not included in the team result.

Semifinal races are formed according to the results of preliminary races according to the scheme: 1^{st} semifinal race -5, 1, 4, 8 result, 2^{nd} semifinal race -6, 2, 3, 7 result. The final race is formed according to the results of the semifinal races according to the scheme: 3, 1, 2, 4 result.

The team and individual championships among men and women in sports disciplines are held separately.

8. Awarding

The teams that took the 1st, 2nd, 3rd all-team place are awarded with cups and diplomas.

Teams that took 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the fire relay and combat deployment are awarded with cups; participants – with medals, diplomas and gifts.

The participants who took 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the individual championship in climbing the assault ladder to the 4th and 2nd floors of the training tower, overcoming the 100-meter obstacle course are awarded with medals, diplomas and gifts.

Coaches of national teams in team sports disciplines are awarded with medals, diplomas and gifts.

9. Participation conditions for the sports delegations and participants of the competitions

The participation fee of 330 (three hundred thirty) US dollars for a member of the sports delegation is transferred to the account of the host country before April 15, 2024 or on the day of arrival at the competition.

The expenses related to the business trip of sports delegations (tickets, accommodation, meals, daily allowances during travel, salary preservation, etc.) are borne by the countries sending the delegation to the competition.

The costs of the competitions are borne by the organizers of the competitions at the expense of their own and attracted funds in accordance with the procedure established by law.

10. Procedure and deadlines for submitting applications

The preliminary application (official letter) on the participation and the quantitative composition of the sports delegation is sent by April, 15th, 2024 at the e-mail: isffr.2001@gmail.com.

The application for the team's participation in competitions in sports disciplines is submitted to the credentials committee on the day of the draw on May, 16^{th} , 2024.

The registration form of the established sample is sent **before April**, 15th, 2024 at the e-mail: isffr.2001@gmail.com.

This information will be used by the organizers of the event for meeting, organizing the departure, hotel rooms booking, production of accreditation badges and solving other organizational issues.
